This workshop specifically addresses Standards 4, 5, and 6 in the QM rubric.</i></p>	<p>Session 4: Addressing Accessibility and Usability.</p> <p><i>View courses from the perspective of improving accessibility and usability for learners in all modalities. Get insight on Universal Design for Learning (UDL) and techniques for creating accessible content and using ALLY to make changes. This workshop specifically addresses Standard 8 in the QM rubric.</i></p>
